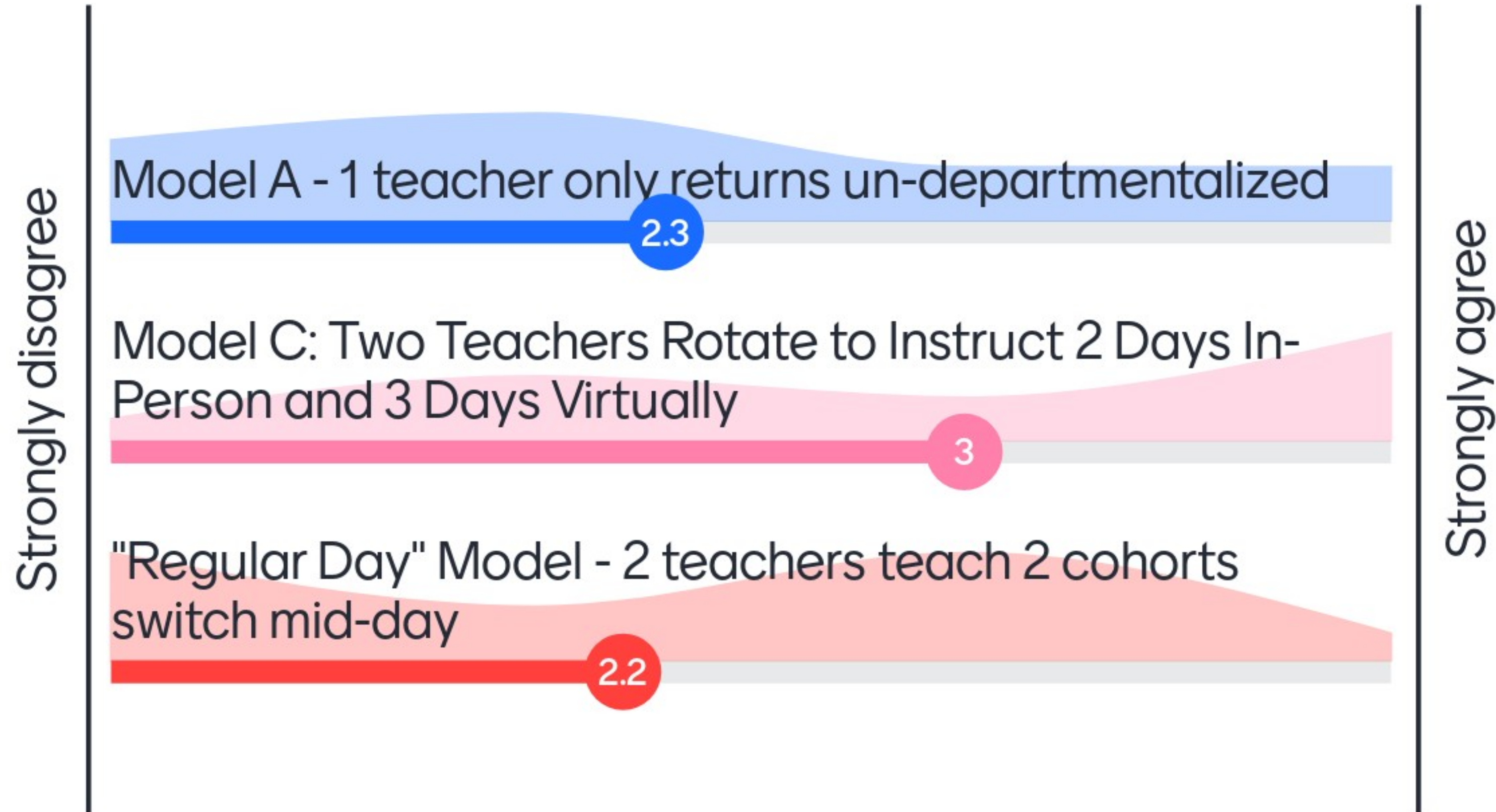


At first glance, which model might be best for us: K-5



What do students, staff, families need to know?

How should we share it?

General timeline with key dates

Community meetings for families. Review instructional model, safety protocols, testimonials, etc.

Specifics about how school will look with safety protocols in place. Weekly emails preferably

How everyone will be kept safe, and how we will deal with a potential outbreak

They need to know EXACTLY what in-person learning would look like (same/different teacher, un-departmentalization, etc), exactly when school will reopen, and ask those who want in-person learning if they will send their kid.

Everyone needs to know how/why (we) derived at the decisions that we made. We should share in all ways: email and maybe phone calls

Need to know: Timing, safety protocols/expectations, selection process; Share via email, website, robocall

How will the virtual experience be degraded for students who do not go to IPL? How many students can a teacher really support in Virtual with quality results.

They need to know exactly what the plan is. Division is evident. However, passive aggressive approach doesn't build trust or community.
