
PTA Meeting Agenda:

What Does A Room Parent Do?

The role of the Room Parent is to make the life of your student's classroom teacher a little easier and to assist in keeping the classroom's families connected and informed.

A Room Parent's involvement varies from classroom to classroom, but, in general, a Room Parent builds class contact lists, sends reminders, coordinates volunteers, assists with classroom-specific projects, and oversees teacher appreciation gifts throughout the year.

A Room Parent will also serve as a liaison between the PTA and the classroom's families. A Room Parent will help to share communications and will also help to coordinate classroom involvement in the annual Cluster Auction and Party.

Serving as a Room Parent is a great way to meet other families, as well as the classroom teachers!

Who Can Be A Room Parent?

Any parent, guardian, or caregiver of a Peabody or Watkins student can serve as a Room Parent.

No experience is needed and we expressly welcome first-year Cluster parents, guardians, and caregivers to volunteer as Room Parents!
